Celebrate **PRIDE**





This pride month we celebrate LGBTQIA+ history with a lineup of fearless documentaries exploring queer roots in music, families showing radical acceptance, and we travel back to 1950s New York where we meet a group of transgender women and gender bending men, who sought refuge and in turn found family.

Thrusting, fabulous and seemingly fearless, Little Richard can genuinely stake a claim on having invented rock 'n' roll. A black artist who grew up in the segregated South, Richard Penniman broke down barriers and took 1950s America by storm.

The Beatles and The Rolling Stones supported him, and took inspiration from his musicianship and stagecraft. He went on to influence artists as diverse as David Bowie, Elton John, Michael Jackson and Prince.

But the inner conflict between his religious beliefs and the music style he pioneered – as well as his battles with his own sexuality - led Little Richard to quit rock 'n' roll not just once, but twice. He spent years feeling that his contribution to music had been overlooked in favor of white rock 'n' roll stars like Elvis Presley and Pat Boone. **American Masters: Little Richard - The King and Queen of Rock and Roll premieres Friday, June 2 at 9:00 pm.**

Spread across the country but connected through private Facebook groups, they call themselves “mama bears” because while their love is warm and fuzzy, they fight ferociously to make the world kinder and safer for all LGBTQ+ people. Although some may have grown up as fundamentalist,

evangelical Christians, mama bears are willing to risk losing friends, family, and faith communities to keep their offspring safe—even if it challenges their belief systems and rips their worlds apart.

MAMA BEARS is an intimate, thought-provoking exploration of the journeys taken by Sara Cunningham and Kimberly Shappley, two “mama bears” —whose profound love for their LGBTQ children has turned them into fierce advocates for the entire queer community — and Tammi Terrell Morris, a young African American lesbian whose struggle for self-acceptance perfectly exemplifies why the mama bears are so vitally important. **Independent Lens: Mama Bears premieres Tuesday, June 20 at 9:00 pm.**

In the 1950s and '60s, an underground network of transgender women and cross-dressing men found refuge at a modest house in the Catskills region of New York. Known as Casa Susanna, the house provided a safe place for them to express their true selves and live for a few days as they had always dreamed—dressed as women without fear of being incarcerated or institutionalized for their self-expression. Told through the memories of those whose visits to the house would change their lives, the film provides a moving look back at a secret world where the persecuted and frightened found freedom, acceptance and, often, the courage to live their lives out of the shadows. **American Experience: Casa Susanna premieres Tuesday, June 27 at 8:00 pm.**

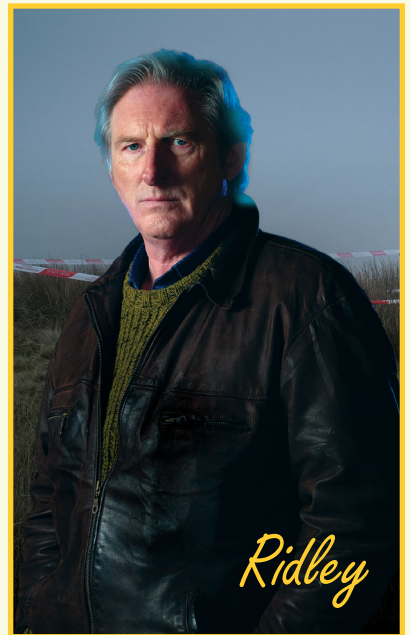

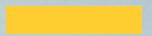
